Home and Aways World Cup Competition 2014 – Join the Fun

Read all about it, read all about it! This year Home and Aways are doing a World Cup Special!

The Rules - The Home and Aways World Cup competition allows you to make select and predict the outcome of EVERY match during the world cup. The qualifying matches are already set up; the knockout fixtures will be added as the competitions progresses.

How to Play the Game - Selections can be made at any time before a match starts. There is no cut off date – you can select and amend each fixture up until kick off time. After kick off, that match is locked down and your selections are set.

You score points by correctly predicting the outcome of each match. You can predict a "Home Win", an "Away Win" or a "Draw". The "Home" team is determined as the team on the left-hand side of the fixture. The "Away" team is the determined as the team on the right-hand side of the fixture. Hint: Don't leave it until the very last minute to make your selections – if you do you run the risk of missing out!

Scoring - The game is scored as follows: Correct Home win = 1 point Correct Away Win = 2 points Correct Draw = 3 points Click the relevant "Home" "Away" or "Draw" box to make your selection for each fixture.

Jokers - Each player is allocated 10 jokers over the competition to be used at any time. To use your joker click the "joker" box to right of the fixture. You cannot select more than 10 jokers. A correct joker doubles that score for that fixture (i.e., Home win = 2 points, Away win = 4 points, draw = 6 points)

Knockout Games - When the competition enters the knockout stage, you can only select a Home win or an Away win. Draws are no longer applicable. If you select the draw box then you will score zero points for that fixture. The winning team will be the team that goes through to the next round, whether the result is after normal time, extra time or penalties.

Winner - The winner will be the player with the highest aggregate score at the end of the competition.

Entry Fee - It costs £10 to enter the competition – all entries must be submitted by Friday 6th June 2014. There are a couple of ways of making your entry payment. Once you have paid, the game will be added to your 'games I'm in' area of the website.

Prize Structure -There will be prizes for the top 5 places. The size of the prize will depend on the size of the pot (i.e. number of entry fees). The prizes will be split 1st – 50%, 2nd – 20%, 3rd – 15%, 4th – 10% and 5th – 5%. As usual, there will be 100% pay out!
